IB Exams May 2021

- Mira Loma is on the non-exam route for May 21 IB Assessment
- Internal Assessments have been submitted to IB for grading
 - o 869 coursework submissions
 - o 249 testing students
 - o 67 Full DP Seniors, 33 Associate Seniors, 40 Certificate Seniors
- Predicted Grades are still being generated by teachers.
- Final list of IB Diploma, Associate and Certificate students submitted to Principal's Secretary today
- Scores will be released July 6th, 2021. Students use their personal code and PIN to access

IB Exams May 2022

- Schedule is the same as May 2021, IB is keeping adjustments to exams and curriculum made for M21
- Juniors have submitted their EE topics, approximately 60 Full Diploma and 40 Associate Seniors next year.

IB MYP Coordinator's Report 21 April 2021

Budgeting and Updates

We are looking at funding and the expenditures of the IB program this year at MLHS and we have decided to shuffle funding around to help provide payment this year to teachers who graded the Personal Projects; especially under the circumstances, it seemed fitting to provide a financial recognition for their extra efforts! We have the money so we are putting it towards what is needed ©

We are looking at trainings for next year, and will be seeking feedback from those who have completed/participated in the virtual trainings this past spring. We will seek to find a solution to the upcoming needs, while exploring all of the new and traditional options in training staff members.

Finalizing the Personal Project submissions

This year we were asking teachers/project supervisors to mark the reports for this assessment. The teachers were briefed on the new expectations and rubric requirements, and those who needed extra support were provided one on one assistance from the coordinator (me). We hosted a virtual Showcase this year, and thanks to Taja Ferrarini and Josh Stinson, I was able to make this happen! The students did a wonderful job on the Personal Project Showcase event and eagerly await the scores from IB.

On a side note, I have yet to find someone to commit to being the Personal Project Coordinator for the upcoming year, so I will continue the course until one is selected. What does this mean? It means that I will be introducing the person projects to the current 9th graders in the coming weeks and getting them set up for a successful summer/fall project.

The Future of IBMYP at MLHS

Our numbers for the incoming class are holding steady but slightly lower than last year, which is to be expected under the circumstances © - Currently at 157 but we have about 10+ applicants in process – so that would make us almost even with last year if they all enroll.

Our teachers are finalizing internal assessments for all courses, and will be posting 1-7 marks for each student by the end of May. I will be updating the ledger for each student accordingly.

Reminder: Community service and Personal Project all factor in to the Certificate and Associate Certificate eligibility, along with the 1-7 scores for all IBMYP courses.
