## Coordinator's Report

### Looking into budget and funding for a few things:

IB fees, training allocations, and recruitment/advertising

- Subs for collaboration days are a bit tricky due to the sub shortage, but we are working on it!
- We currently have 3 teachers slated to attend trainings (virtually) this fall/winter.
- We posted an Ad in the Inside Publication that circulates around the Sacramento Area regarding our upcoming Parent Information Night/Event. This year, the principal has once again allocated funds to cover this Ad. Yay!
- We do have some funds available, especially for virtual trainings most run Fri-Sun. Teachers are encouraged to retrain if curriculum areas have changed, or if they are looking to take over a project or are assigned a new course to teach. These trainings are LIVE, 8 am EST, and interactive. They are not simply working through modules independently. We shall see what the feedback is from those who attend this semester. It saves on funds and provides opportunity for more teachers to be trained.

### IB evaluation - Matters to be Addressed

The matters to be addressed are being addressed. 😊

- We are working to organize assessment folders for each curriculum area, to collect a bank of samples for each assessment task, from each teacher and each level.
- I have begun work with Winston Churchill Middle School to organize collaboration between the two campuses. Teachers will attend 2 meetings this year, one each semester, to discuss common assessments, Approaches to Learning (ATL), International Mindedness practices, and a few other focus areas.

### Personal Projects and Community Service

The 10<sup>th</sup> grade students are working on their personal projects. Some started in June and have been working over the summer to complete as much as possible, while others started in August and are working to navigate the project with their other schoolwork; nonetheless, they are all on their way at this point. The first checkpoint has passed, and students are receiving marks in both English and History courses for completing the checkpoint. For some students, the personal project is not a requirement, and those students will complete the independent research paper assigned – this is intended to ensure they too receive the proper preparation for the DP level long-term research projects, and to help them get points in the gradebook for their English and History courses.

Ms. Jacks came into the science classrooms and presented to the 9<sup>th</sup> graders about the IBMYP Community Service requirements and the ManageBac system used to document service and projects.
